

 - 2. The IQAC, after verification of academic credentials and API scores recommended the granting of promotions to the following teachers and staff of the University library.



3. The IQAC examined the file pertaining to the clarification sought in connection with the granting of promotion to Dr.Harikumaran Nair from Assistant Professor, Stage I to Assistant Professor Stage II and found it to be in order. The detailed report was discussed and approved.

4. The IQAC resolved to recommend to the University that the quality improvement measures suggested by it be expedited by the Joint Registrar, Registrar and Vice Chancellor.

- 5. The IQAC discussed in detail the need for having a full time Director, Planning for the University to ensure timely and efficient identification, submission and faster utilization of Central and State funds.
- 6. The IQAC discussed the report of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council and the granting of A Grade with a CGPA of 3.24 to the Mahatma Gandhi University. The Cell also discussed the ways in which improvements can be made in future. It was decided to organise a one-day Workshop to review the NAAC report.
- 7. The IQAC also resolved to strive for recognition as a University with Potential for Excellence. In this regard Schools/Centres will be asked to strengthen their activities and aim for recognition as Centres of Excellence for which administrative and financial support may be given by the Administration.
