- 5) In compliance with the Persons with Disability Act 2016, it is decided to provide various concessions to differently abled students
- 6) Courses should be designed as multi-disciplinary as directed by the UGC.
- 7) IAQC recommend to improve the activities of Spoken Tutorial Project organised by IIT Bombay and also recommend to conduct a Faculty Development Training programme
- 8) Infrastructure facilities in the Teaching Departments are to be improved using the Department Development Fund.
- It is recommended to invite applications for SICI (Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute) from various schools and affiliated colleges of the University.
- 10)IQAC recommend to invite the great grand-daughter of Mahatma Gandhi Dr. Kirti Menon for a talk on the topic "Gandhi under African Skies"
- 11) Sports infrastructure facilities to be enhanced.
- 12) The research activities should be done in accordance with the existing orders of the University and the research should contribute to the society.
