## **Scholarship Policy**

Mahatma Gandhi University supports the student community with various scholarships to the students of various categories. This is offered to the Post Graduate, Ph. D., M. Phil. and Post Doctoral students. There are scholarships offered by the University from its own fund. Apart from merit scholarships, there are various financial assistance schemes through Student Welfare Fund viz., Scholarship for NCC/NSS candidates participated in Republic Day Parade, Financial assistance to critical diseases, scholarships to differently-abled and transgender students, scholarship to Youth Festival winners etc. These scholarships are issued to support the students of the University for meeting their expenses related to the studies viz., tuition fees, hostel expenses, travel expenses, seminar fees, research and publication etc.

Apart from the own funded scholarships, the University also extend the scholarships to students from around 30 external entities.

The notification is published well in advance for the students to apply for various categories. The scholarship applications received shall be scrutinized by a committee to ensure an equitable distribution of scholarship. The eligibility to qualify for scholarship varies on the nature of scholarship which could be merit, merit cum means, reservation, government eligibility criteria and many more. All eligible students are required to submit the university scholarship application form well within the stipulated time. The selection committee may request for additional information and documents as deemed appropriate. Award of scholarship also depends on availability of funds during that particular academic year. Some of the scholarships are eligible for renewal.

Following are guidelines, subject to change, set by the university to consider award of scholarship and or any other forms of financial support:

- Only one scholarship for the student in a particular academic year subject to renewal if all conditions are fulfilled
- All records of the awardees with respect to academics and behavior are thoroughly examined prior to renewal
- No student is allowed to hold more than one scholarship at a time, irrespective of type and amount of scholarship and or study support donations.
- All the scholarships awarded by the university are subjected to the approval of the Committee and the Hon. Vice chancellor of the University.
