



Action Taken Report during 2021 - 22

Mahatma Gandhi University collected feedback from the major stakeholders of the university - Students, Teachers, Alumni, Academic Peers and Employers, under the aegis of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), for the academic year 2021-22. All Schools/ Departments/ Centres were included in the process. The feedback on the various aspects of the curriculum followed by the university was collected through a web-based mechanism developed by the IQAC (www.iqacmgu.org). The feedback obtained from various stakeholders were then communicated to the Heads and IQAC coordinators of various Schools/ Departments/ Centres for further action.

The major steps taken by Schools/ Departments/ Centres are as follows:

- Implemented the OBE curriculum in tune with the provisions of NEP 2020
- Academic calendar was revamped to enhance the student involvement in social empowerment through co-curricular activities
- Steps were taken to enhance the frequency of mentor-mentee meetings to provide extended support to students
- Slow learners were given remedial classes to improve their performance
- Created avenues for improving the technical knowledge and communication skills of students
- Introduced courses related to instrumentation techniques for programmes in science departments/ schools

- Encouraged the use of e-learning portal (Vidyamrutham) by students and faculty members
- Internship components was introduced in the curriculum of schools/departments
- Enriched the curriculum through initiatives to improve the industry-institute interaction


Action Taken by IQAC

IQAC also provided funds to Schools/ Departments/ Centres, to develop the infrastructure.

The newly recruited teachers were provided seed money with the purpose of enhancing their research and extension activities and to develop new courses, so as to meet the requirements of stakeholders.
